

Laps at Levels Terms and Conditions of entry 2022

Caroline Bay Rock and Hop event organiser Hospice South Canterbury Inc will now be referred to as "The event organiser".

All participants, by agreeing to these terms and conditions and signing the indemnity form on the cruise day, understand that they will uphold all the South Canterbury Car Club Inc health and safety requirements as well as all other safety aspects and conditions pursuant to holding a motorsport event at Levels International Motor Raceway.

When you secure your registration and choose to partake in any of the Laps at Levels cruises or to park in the Levels International Motor Raceway Event precinct, you are agreeing to these contractual "Terms and Conditions" which are also clearly posted on our event website carolinebayrockandhop.co.nz/even-more

- You confirm all information provided is true and correct.
- You understand Event Photographers may take a photo that includes you or your vehicle. These photos may be used in Social Media and Marketing at the discretion of the Event Organiser.

You must

Obtain a vehicle pass sticker at the Levels Event Registration area upon entry and display this on the front windscreen of your car. This pass is only valid if it is legible and it is not mutilated, altered or obscured in any way.

Obey all volunteers and park only in the allocated areas.

Not exceed the speed limit of 10kph when within the parking and entrance area.

Put your rubbish in a bin onsite or take it away with you. – Stall holders

The event organiser reserves the right to refuse or revoke entry for irresponsible/unsafe behaviour at their discretion. The event organiser will take no responsibility for any costs incurred by this action.

Rules regarding the participation in Laps at Levels cruises.

- Security of vehicles is the owner's responsibility.
- Your vehicle must have a current Warrant of Fitness and Registration.
- The vehicle's driver must have a current NZ Drivers Licence.
- All passengers in your vehicle must be wearing a seatbelt. The exception is if your vehicle is pre 1959 and does not have seatbelts. If not, you need to enter the Pre 1954 section of the event. These vehicles must enter in the pre-1959 cruise.
- Passengers must be aged 12 or older.
- You must attend the pre cruise safety briefing and sign the indemnity form provided.
- Vehicles will be stagger started, please pay attention when it is your turn.
- All vehicles must follow the pace car which will start slower and speed up after the first two laps. Each cruise is six laps after which you must pull off the track.
- The pace car cannot be passed at any stage.
- There is to be no passing of entrants' vehicles anywhere except the back straight of the track.
- When passing you need to flash your headlights to let the vehicle in front know that you are coming
- Vehicles can only go two wide on the back straight.
- All drivers will be required to be breath tested before entering the track.
- Ability to drive the track will be determined by the Car Controller
- If there is a breakdown on the track that vehicle must pull left off the track and everyone stay in the car until told by the safety crew that they can exit the vehicle.
- If there is a breakdown all mobile vehicles will be directed to pit lane until it is safe to re-enter.
- Marshalls must be obeyed at all times.
- If you have registered in the wrong section the event organiser reserves the right to change your cruise time.
- No dogs are allowed at Levels International Raceway.
- **Any passing on the wrong part of the track or unsafe behaviour will result in instant dismissal from the track and the whole Rock and Hop event.**

The Event Organiser will endeavour to have the event running on time but please be patient as this is the first time this event has been run.

Please remember that unless you have specific insurance your vehicles are not insured while on the track. The event organiser takes no responsibility for damage to vehicles on or off the track. As this is a motorsport venue all entrants are advised to do their own personal risk analysis and check with their insurer.

Gazebos and temporary structures

Only Clubs or authorised stallholders are permitted to erect a gazebo and must obtain prior permission from the event organiser. Please email fundraiser@hospicesc.org.nz for an application form. This must be done in writing and will be granted only if we have the appropriate area for the structure. If weather conditions make it dangerous clubs may be asked to remove the structure. Club members must respect that the event is a family one and any intoxicated, dangerous or obnoxious behaviour will result in possible expulsion from the event. Clubs must assign a named person to be responsible for their club site and ensure that all litter is removed from the site.

Strictly no fires are permitted at Levels International Raceway.

Advertising

Strictly no advertising is allowed at the Levels Raceway, however clubs are invited to display a banner or board with their name etc. No commercial advertising is allowed unless classified as a sponsor by the organisers. No sale of any merchandise, alcohol or car parts or any form of business is to be carried out by anyone unless previously agreed to in writing by the organising committee.

Our Refund Policy, excepting the Covid-19 and the weather clauses below, is that all Rock and Hop Vehicle entries are non-refundable but are transferable. If you wish to transfer your entry, we must have your new vehicle registration number and contact details. Otherwise entry may not be guaranteed. Please contact us on 03 687 7670

Covid-19:

We will offer full refunds to all car registrants, ticket buyers and stallholders should the 2022 Caroline Bay Rock and Hop be cancelled due to Covid-19 restrictions, including the Laps at Levels section. **Our intention is to give as much notice as possible about this. It is also our intention to either hold the whole event, or not hold it at all.**

All participants must obey the covid tracing requirements of the time as these will be enforced.

Weather: It may be necessary to cancel the Laps at Levels event due to weather conditions. If this happens all tickets will be refunded.

General

It may be necessary for reasons beyond our control to change the content and timing of the Laps at Levels programme. The event organiser will ensure any changes are advised as soon as possible.

The event organiser reserves the right to amend the rules to cater for changed circumstances or conditions.

The event organiser shall have no liability for any death or bodily injury, or loss of or damage to property, of anyone attending the Laps at Levels event, whether arising from such attendance, or in relation to the provision or use of the facilities at the event. You agree to indemnify the event organiser against any claim in respect of any such liability (and the costs and expenses incurred by the event organiser in relation thereto).

Please remember any passing on the wrong part of the track or unsafe behaviour will result in instant dismissal from the track and the whole Rock and Hop event.
