Site Confirmation

Registration of interest must be received by **Monday 18th January 2021**, which includes completed and signed site application a form and full payment. Registration does not ensure automatic entry, Caroline Bay Rock and Hop reserves the right to accept or reject any site application. Caroline Bay Rock and Hop will try to ensure that sites are allocated fairly and reasonable. Confirmation of your site number and site map will be sent prior to the event.

Payment Options

Cancellation

Cancellations are still liable for full payment of the site unless the site can be resold.

Covid-19: We will offer full refunds to all car registrants, ticket buyers and stallholders should the 2021 Caroline Bay Rock and Hop be cancelled due to Covid-19 restrictions. **Our intention is to give as much notice as possible about this, with a final decision date of March 1, 2021. It is also our intention to either hold the whole event, or not hold it at all.**

If the event is cancelled for other reasons, such as inclement weather on the day, refunds for stallholders will be available.

It may be necessary for reasons beyond our control to change the content and timing of the programme, the entertainment, or the venue at any time prior to the event date. The event organisers will ensure any changes are advised as soon as possible.

If due to weather conditions the Gala Day cannot be held at Caroline Bay, you will be notified as soon as the decision has been made.

Setup

Caroline Bay will be accessible for setup on the Friday 19th March however this will be at your own risk. Gates will be open again from 7.30am on Saturday 20th March 2021. Setup must be completed by 9.30am before we open to the public at 10.00am. Late stallholders may be refused right of entry.

Pack Up

Dismantling must not commence till closing of the event. Sites must be packed down within 2 hours of the event closing at 4.00pm.

Power Sites

Power is available. Please indicate on your application form. Stallholders must provide their own certified extension leads. These **MUST BE AT LEAST 15 Mtrs long**. The \$30 power charge is for one extension cord only, if you require more than this you will be charged for them.

Food

All food sold onsite must comply with the NZ Food Safety Authority Standards. You must bring everything you need for food production. You will not have access to power without prior arrangement. **All stall holders cooking food must supply their own fire extinguisher. Please display a current food licence and be aware that we will be checking LPG Bottles for compliance.**

Rubbish

Stall holders are responsible for the removal of all their own site rubbish. Your site must be returned to its original condition upon dismantling.

Other Requirements

No dogs are permitted at the Festival at any time. All vehicles must be removed from the site area by 9.30am and parked in the designated stall holders parking area.

Liability
